



“2006” Cranberry Festival Art Show & Exhibit Rules
Christian Life Academy Building
Seneca, PA 16346
September 28-30, 2006

You are invited to participate in the 2006 Cranberry Festival Art Show sponsored by the 2006 Cranberry Festival Committee. This year's exhibit will be held on Thursday, September 28 and will run through Saturday, September 30, 2006. Art Show location will be the Christian Life Academy Building in Seneca, PA.

ENTRY INFORMATION:

- Fee's: \$5.00 per entry/per Adult, if the artist submits 3 or more pieces \$4.00 per entry. - Please make checks payable to the Venango Area Chamber of Commerce.
- Youth entries up-to 3 pieces FREE, \$2.00 for each additional entry over 3 pieces.

CATEGORIES:

- Two-Dimensional Arts (includes oil, pastel, acrylic, pencil, watercolor)
- Three-Dimensional Arts (includes sculpture, 3-D woodcarving, fine craft, stained glass, textiles)
- Photography (film or digital – color/black or white unedited)
- Enhanced Photography (film or digital – color/black or white edited or altered by a photographic process)
- Scrapbooking

**All artwork except Three-Dimensional and Scrapbook entries should be matted and ready to hang. **

PRIZE RIBBIONS & CERTIFICATES:

- Exhibits will be professionally judged and ribbons awarded for first, second, and third place in each category per division of entry.
- Certificates will also be made for “**Best of Show and People’s Choice.**”
- Donated prizes may also be given based on availability.

GENERAL RULES:

- Artwork must be original (no kits) or computer generated molds, copies or reproductions may be entered. **The show committee reserves the right to refuse any entry that is inappropriate for family viewing.**

- Previous prize-winning entries in the Oil Heritage Art Show or any other local art show can not be entered
- All art work should be clearly labeled with the following information:
 - ❖ Name
 - ❖ Division of Entry
 - ❖ Classification
 - ❖ Title
 - ❖ Price if for Sale
- Two-Dimensional Art Work must be framed, wired and ready for installation upon delivery. Improperly prepared art (not completed and/or ready for display) will be excluded from the Art Show.
- There will be a 15% commission on all sales. Your selling price should reflect this amount if you elect to place your artwork up for sale.
- Sold artwork will remain in the show until it closes. Artists will receive payment by mail following the show.
- Artwork will not be accepted after 8:00pm on September 27, 2006.
- The admission of art to this show constitutes the artist's permission for general publicity.

HOURS ART WORK WILL BE DISPLAYED FOR PUBLIC VIEWING:

- Thursday, Sept 28, 2006 from 4-8:30pm
- Friday, Sept 29, 2006 from 4-8:30pm (**We will have a special guest Artist this evening and we would like all artists/families/friends to attend**) – Friday night is also open to the general public.
- Saturday, Sept 30, 2006 from 10am – 3:00pm

DELIVERY AND PICK-UP OF ARTWORK:

- Artwork must be delivered to the Christian Life Academy building on Monday, September 25 between 5-8pm or on Tuesday September 26 between 5-8pm.
- Artwork will not be accepted after 8pm on September 26, 2006 and no refunds will be made.
- Artwork must be removed on Saturday, September 30 from 4-6pm or on Monday , October 2, 2006 between the hours of 5-8 pm.

LIABILITY:

The Venango Chamber of Commerce, Cranberry Festival Committee or Christian Life Academy will be responsible for theft, loss or damage to any work submitted for judging or exhibition. No insurance will be carried by the exhibiting agency, but all responsible care will be used in handling art work.

You are invited to help participate by serving as a volunteer/show guide. If you are willing to contribute several hours of time, we do welcome your help. We will be seeking "show sitters" to be available at all times when the exhibit is open to the public. Please call 814-677-2447 ext 440 or 814-673-5641.
